### *Last Week's Meeting...*

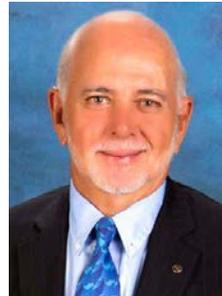
There was no meeting on January 16<sup>th</sup> because the Holiday Inn Pointe-Claire did not have a room available for us, because of a major conference being held there.

Rotary International's *new* President-elect, **Barry Rassin**, laid out his vision for the future of Rotary as he addressed the International Assembly of incoming District Governors and their spouses and partners and presented our theme for the Rotary year 2018-19 that begins on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

In San Diego, on January 14<sup>th</sup>, he spoke to the Governor-elect of every district in the world, including our own DG-elect, **Martha Weaver** and her partner, Jim. But President-elect Barry was also talking to our President-elect **Murray** and Carol and, indeed, to every one of the 1.2 million Rotarians around the world, that is, to every one of us!
